

The God to whom we pray graciously gives us all things.

**God is *Jehovah-jireh*. He is the Lord who will provide.**

When you pray to *Jehovah-jireh* . . .

Thank Him for providing eternal life. *For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life* (John 3:16).

Thank Him for the Holy Spirit. *Your Father gives the Holy Spirit to those who ask* (Luke 11:13).

Believe God's promises. *Jehovah* had promised Abraham many descendants, so when Isaac asked, "*Where is the lamb for the burnt offering?*" Abraham answered, "*God himself will provide the lamb*" (Genesis 22:7-8).

Obey His commands. Because Abraham was willing to sacrifice his son, God showed himself as the *Jehovah-jireh*, the Lord who will provide (Genesis 22).

Don't set your heart on things that won't last. *Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will depart* (Job 1:21).

Always praise, no matter what. *The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised* (Job 1:21).

Have faith. *Do not be worried about your life, as to what you will eat or what you will drink; nor for your body, as to what you will put on . . . for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things* (from Matthew 6:25-33).

Claim His promises. *My God will meet all your needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus* (Philippians 4:19).

Don't forget that God is the one who provides. *When you have eaten and are satisfied, praise the Lord for the good land He has given you . . . it is God who gives you the ability to produce wealth* (Deuteronomy 8:10,18).
