

Who is this King of glory? He is the true and living God; the everlasting King who rules over all the earth. He is the LORD, strong and mighty, the LORD, mighty in battle! The LORD of hosts, He is the King of glory (Jeremiah 10:10; Psalm 24:8,10; 47:2).

When you pray to the King of kings . . .

Remember that He listens. *The LORD is king forever and ever. . . . O LORD, you hear the desire of the afflicted; you will strengthen their heart; you will incline your ear to do justice to the fatherless and the oppressed, so that man who is of the earth may strike terror no more* (Psalm 10:16-18).

Honor Him. *The Lord Jesus Christ is the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see. To him be honor and dominion* (1 Timothy 6:15-16).

Give Him glory. *To the King of ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen* (1 Timothy 1:17).

Fear Him. *The LORD, the Most High, is to be feared, a great king over all the earth. . . . He chose our heritage for us* (Psalm 47:2-4).

Do what is right. *Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of your kingdom* (Hebrews 1:8).

Be humble. *Behold your king is coming to you, humble and mounted on a donkey* (Matthew 21:5).

Praise Him for what He does. *The whole multitude of his disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen, saying, "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest"* (Luke 19:37-38).

Praise Him for who He is. *God is the King of all the earth; sing praises with a psalm! God reigns over the nations; God sits on his holy throne* (Psalm 47:7-8).
