Remember that the God to whom we pray is *Jehovah-raphe*. He is the Lord who heals.

Pray simply. When Moses prayed for his sister Miriam, he said, "O God, please heal her." She was healed. (from Numbers 12:1-5)

Pray confidently. "Heal her, O Lord, and she will be healed, save her and she will be saved, for You are the one we praise. (from Jeremiah 17:9,14)

Pray with faith. A sick woman wanted healing, so she touched Jesus. He answered her silent plea, "Your faith has healed you. (from Mark 5:25-34)

Pray with thankfulness. One leper, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God with a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him. (Luke 17:15)

Pray for God to be glorified. When the blind man was healed, someone asked Jesus, "Who sinned that this man was born blind?" Jesus said, "Neither he nor his parents sinned. This happened so the work of God might be displayed in his life. (from John 9:1-3)

Pray for God's will to be done. "If we ask anything according to his will he hears us (1 John 5:14).

Remember to pray for the heart, soul, and mind of those who are sick.

Pray that they would know God's love. Nothing will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:39)

Pray that they would believe that *for those who love God all things work together for good.* (Romans 8:28)

Pray that they would be comforted. God is the *Father of mercies and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in our affliction.* (2 Corinthians 1:3-4)

Pray that they would think about *whatever is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent and praiseworthy.* (from Philippians 4:8)
